Deerlick Astronomy Village Rules

- 1. **Memberships** The Deerlick Astronomy Village is a private facility and is available for use by members only. Your membership must be in good standing to access the Membership Field at DAV. Members must have a DAV Membership Parking Permit on display at all times while on the site. Upon arrival to the site you must register at the Sales Office. If no one is there sign the register and pay your camping fee.
- 2. **Guests** You are allowed to bring up to two guests to the property if they have signed a release form. Deposit this form in the camp fee box located in the Sales Office. Guests are required to pay a \$10/night camp fee. If you wish to bring more then 2 guest you must contact the main office prior to arrival.
- 3. **Lighting Policies** Dark sky rules apply for everyone, everywhere on the property. Please obey all lighting rules. No white lights are allowed anywhere on the property after dark.
- 4. **Noise Policy** Quiet time is every morning until noon. This applies to pets and children.
- 5. Green Laser Policy Green laser pointers are a great training aid and are welcome on the site with the following rules: 1) You are not allowed to point lasers at any person or object not located on this planet, and that includes aircraft. 2) Imagers have right of refusal with it comes to laser pointers.
- 6. **Facilities** As a DAV Member you are allowed access to the facilities on the site but members are responsible for any damages. The owners of DAV reserve the right and may periodically close Grier's Field for maintenance or private events. Please check the <u>DAV Event Calendar</u> for updates.
- 7. **Parking** Parking is allowed on the Membership field. Please plan on arriving before dark. If you plan on leaving before dawn then please park your car along the entrance road with car lights facing towards the gate. No driving is allowed on the field after dark unless observing has ended due to weather issues or it is an emergency. In the case of an emergency please either 1) Use the buddy system. Have someone guide you off the site, or 2) alert everyone on the field that you must leave and use your lights; this gives them time to cover their eyes. We don't want anyone injured so use common sense.
- 8. **Trash** You are responsible for collecting and removing your own trash. Leave the field and premises just as you found them, and if you see any clutter please pick it up, we want the site to stay neat and clean. There are no trashcans or dumpsters on the site so you must take your trash with you. There are public dumpsters in the City of Sharon.
